POSITION PURPOSE:

Teacher-learner will study Takelma Language and progress to a conversational level of fluency as measured by the Northwest Indian Languages Benchmarks. Responsibilities include planning, coordinating, and implementing program activities. In addition, they will be able to use and contribute to Takelma language resources, as measured by completed curriculum units; and be able to teach language to Tribal families and Tribal youth in both the Preschool and Afterschool programs, as well as providing language-based activities to the EHYC summer programming. Job duties will be varied, and assignments will be made that create positive outcomes for the Takelma language program. This is a grant funded position and will run for the duration of the grant ending June 30, 2025.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Track progress towards language learning goals via regular self-assessments.
- Plan, coordinate, implement, communicate program activities.
- Attend training and workshops and progress in the following skills:
 - Understanding Takelma linguistic resources.
 - Teaching Takelma language.
 - Developing curriculum for family classes.
- Track skill-development for the above skills.
- Use and contribute to Takelma language resources.
- Teach language to Tribal families, EHYC and Yimisa youth.
- Track participation of Tribal members in classes and activities.
- Contribute to archiving and distribution of all instructional materials.
- Support staff in Grow Your Own (GYO) grant goals.
- Other duties as necessary to support the GYO grant.

- Experience in lesson planning and curriculum building.
