POSITION PURPOSE:

- Develop and implement personalized treatment plans based on patients' unique circumstances.
- Monitor and evaluate patients' progress towards achieving treatment goals.
- Collaborate with an interdisciplinary team, including medical, behavioral health, and traditional wellness providers, to ensure coordinated care.
- Educate patients on the risks and consequences of substance abuse, as well as techniques for relapse prevention.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date records of patient interactions and progress.
- Demonstrate respect for and understanding of Tribal sovereignty, history, and the unique experiences of Native and Indigenous communities.
- Promote a strength-based approach that recognizes historical trauma, resilience, and cultural identity as essential components of recovery

- Minimum of 2 years of experience in substance abuse counseling.
- Knowledge of evidence-based treatment modalities for addiction (e.g., CBT, MI, relapse prevention)
